Dear St. Paul UMC Members and Friends,

I greet you all in the name of our Savior Jesus Christ. May His peace, joy, and love be upon everyone as we look forward to the coming months of our faith journey in the Lord. It has been 8 months since the conference assigned St. Paul UMC as my 2nd charge and I must admit, it has been challenging but at the same time exciting because of the opportunities given by God to do more work in building the Kingdom. And so, I urge everyone to have a heart for mission and outreach as ordained by our resurrected

Christ in <u>Matthew 28:16-20</u>. With this great commission by God in Christ, I will give more attention to **3 basic missions of the church.**

- 1. Remain Prayerful The people of God must always be in a prayerful attitude. Paul wrote to the Ephesians in <u>Ephesians 6:18-23</u> ¹⁸ Never stop praying, especially for others. Always pray by the power of the Spirit. Stay alert and keep praying for God's people. Praying and other spiritual practices are our way of life. <u>Proverbs 3:5-6</u> ⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.
- **2. Go Out and Share** to confine ourselves comfortably in the walls of the building will not help in the spread of the gospel. Jesus went from town to town meeting people from all walks of life. He even preached in synagogues even if he was not welcomed. But did it stop Him from telling the Good News of salvation? Certainly not. This is what God wants for all of us.
- 3. Encourage and Invite I know it has been hard to bring people back into our building. It hurts to be rejected by our own loved ones. To change their minds to come back and worship with us again seems impossible. But nothing is impossible with God. And if we all become messengers of Christ, we can turn this community around for the glory of God. In Romans 10:14-15 Paul writes: ¹⁴ How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? ¹⁵ And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!"

And let us not forget, the Holy Spirit. <u>Ephesians 6:11-13</u> says, "Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of darkness in this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."

This is what my heart desires in 2024. Let us all work together in the name of our Resurrected Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Till next newsletter...




